People's Choice Prize Conditions of Entry

1. Definitions

Promoter: Waverley Council ABN 12502583608, 55 Spring St, Bondi Junction, NSW 2022.

Award: This process by which Entrants vote to select the People's Choice Prize from shortlisted authors in the Mark and Evette Moran Nib Literary Award.

Prize categories: There are two prizes a) for the author receiving the most entries in this Award and b) for an entrant, drawn at random from all valid entries submitted.

The winning entry from an entrant will be selected at random, and the People's Choice Prize winner will be the author who receives the most number of votes in this Award.

Entrant: A person who has submitted an entry containing a vote in accordance with these Conditions of Entry.

2. Entry Method: To enter The Nib Waverley Library Award for Literature 2019 People's Choice competition Entrants must either:

- i. visit www.haveyoursaywaverley.com.au during the Award Period, complete the online voting form and provide all the mandatory details, including choosing their preferred author from the judges shortlist; or
- ii. Complete a voting form using the paper ballots provided at the Waverley Library Foyer, the Waverley Council Service Centre, Gertrude & Alice Bookstore and Café or at Mark Moran Vaucluse.

Only one valid entry will be submitted into the draw per Entrant. The member of the public entry will be selected at random, while the People's Choice Award winner will be the author who receives the most number of votes, as voted by members of the public through this competition.

If for any reason, an Entrant fails to comply with any part of these Conditions of Entry, or a winning entry is deemed not to comply with these Conditions of Entry, the Promoter reserves the right to discard that Entrant's entry and proceed as if the entrant had not entered. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

3. Restrictions: Subject to the restrictions in this clause, anyone who has agreed to comply with these Conditions of Entry may enter. Councillors, officers, management, employees and other staff and their immediate families of the Promoter are ineligible to enter.

4. Award Period: The competition commences on 31 August 2019 at 3.30pm and closes on Monday 14 October 2019 at 11.59pm.

5 Prize draw. The winner will be drawn at 10.30am on Thursday 1 November 2019 at the North Bondi RSL Club through a raffle draw. The winner will also be advertised on www.waverley.nsw.gov.au by Thursday 8 November 2019. The author who receives the most votes will be announced on Thursday 14 November 2019 at the Nib Presentation event at North Bondi RSL.

6. Prize Details: The author who receives the highest number of votes will receive a \$1,000 prize. One Entrant will also be drawn randomly from all the votes received and will win a \$100 voucher for Gertrude and Alice Book Store Cafe, a set of the 2019 Nib Shortlisted books and an invitation for two to attend the exclusive Nib Presentation event at North Bondi RSL on Thursday 14 November 2019.

Receipt of prizes will be arranged through Waverley Council in consultation with the winners. The winners' names and suburbs may be published on www.waverley.nsw.gov.au. The prize is not transferable or exchangeable, nor can it be redeemed in cash.

7. Responsibilities: The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, delayed, illegible, corrupted or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence whether due to error, omission, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction, transmission interruption, communications failure or otherwise. The Promoter has no control over communications networks or services, the Internet, or computer or telephone networks or lines and accepts no responsibility for any problems associated with them, whether due to traffic congestion, technical malfunction or otherwise. Entries via online are deemed to be received at the time of receipt into the Promoter's database not at the time of transmission by the Entrant.
