


Ideas

Listed here are all of the ideas in the report. These ideas have been developed by the three design teams that participated in the design charettes.

You can view the full list of ideas on pages 36 to 49 of the report. This list includes ideas for the Waverley Bus Depot and Centennial Park, but Council has resolved not to pursue any of the ideas for these sites other than those that could help to improve the external appearance of the depot. Any comments on these ideas will be collated and used for advocacy purposes only.

The ideas have been categorised into four broad themes:

- TRAFFIC
- PUBLIC DOMAIN
- ART, CULTURE, HERITAGE
- BUILT FORM





TRAFFIC

- 1 Connect Grafton St to Syd Einfeld Dr via slip lanes and new roundabout on Grafton St.
- Nelson St to become a shared zone with pedestrian preference.
- 3 Simplify and realign intersection at Oxford St/Syd Einfeld Dr and Ocean St to create a new urban block.
- 4 Close Oxford St westbound slip lane, and widen York Rd between Oxford St and Syd Einfeld Dr.
- 5 Relocate bus entry and exit from Oxford St to York Rd.
- 6 Partially relocate bus entry/exit to York Rd from Oxford St.
- Provide a new series of laneways for connectivity and walkability.
- 8 Oxford St widening: set back buildings along northern side of Oxford St by 3m–4.2m (between Leswell St and York Rd).

PUBLIC DOMAIN

- Quality plantings and street trees to improve streetscape.
- Under awning lighting and feature street lighting for Oxford St to reinforce high street character.
- Consolidate street signage to declutter public domain.
- Plant deciduous street trees along Oxford St.
- Install new street furniture, including bike racks and public seating.
- Make Nelson St a shared zone for pedestrian amenity and traffic calming.
- Create widened shared way and upgrade bus shelter on southern side of Oxford St in front of bus depot.
- Create new angled setback to frame the future entry to Centennial Parklands, and a public forecourt.
- Create new setback as public forecourt for proposed cultural facility.

- Improve planting along Syd Einfeld Dr/Oxford St to reinforce/create urban boulevarde.
- Widen footpath along northern side of Oxford St by 3m.
- Provide new laneways and pedestrian connections north of Oxford St.
- Provide new laneways and pedestrian connections south of Oxford St (between existing laneway and Mill Hill St and Denison St).
- Provide bigger public square to northern side of Syd Einfeld Dr.
- Upgrade public footpaths and crossings, including kerb ramps along southern side of Oxford St.
- 24 Continuous street awnings along Oxford St to reinforce high street character.
- Redefine squares, shared zones and entries to north eastern corner of Centennial Park.

- Install new wider and lower pedestrian bridge over Syd Einfeld Dr for pedestrians and cyclists, and to improve connections with the Woollahra community.
- Adaptive reuse of Woollahra Reservoir for public use.
- Provide an elevated, planted promenade along the narrowed section of Syd Einfeld Dr.

ART, CULTURE, HERITAGE

- 29 Foster local community input on art projects, including short term popups.
- Provide touchable and playable landscape features.
- Preserve heritage-listed Nelson Hotel and Westgate House on corner of Oxford St and St James Rd and historic Grafton St terraces.
- Re-establish urban block once the site of the historic Hoyts cinema and diner with a built form landmark.
- 33 Create iconic precinct entries through public art infrastructure (eg. water towers and bus shelter).

- 34 Retain fine grain lots.
- Provide new cultural and community spaces to foster entrepreneurship and encourage education.
- Provide public art on street facing facades.
- Provide development incentives in return for cultural assets.
- Encourage/support local business diversity that embody the place (eg. cafes, food, bike hub, healthy lifestyle).
- Reveal and adaptively reuse Woollahra Reservoir.
- Provide a gateway to Centennial Park.
- 41 Reinforce and enhance legacy of Oxford St as a significant historic avenue/boulevarde.
- 42 Provide a new cultural and/or youth centre on the bus depot frontage to attract local, regional and global artworks.

BUILT FORM

- 43 1 storey park activity hub at traffic island between Syd Einfeld Dr and Oxford St.
- Mew 10 storey development site at former traffic island between Syd Einfeld Dr and Oxford St.
- 45 2–3 storey development north and south of Oxford St, from York Rd to Leswell and Denison Sts, with partial increase to 5-storey.
- 46 5–9 storey development north of Oxford St, between York Rd and Leswell St.
- 47 6–9 storey development north and south of Oxford St, between York Rd and Nelson St, with 6 storey podium to Oxford St and slender 9 storey blocks along Syd Einfeld Dr.
- 48 Discourage large scale site/lot amalgamations.

Different options for development on the bus depot frontage, including:

- 49 4 storey development over bus depot frontage, totalling 6 stories in height.
- 50 Depot frontage to be set back for 3–4 storey residential development along the north and west frontages.
- Depot frontage to be set back for 2–3 storey development along the north frontage.
