Waverley Council are planning to make improvements to Varna Park! Council has received \$280,000 in funding from the NSW Government through the Stronger Communities Fund to improve Varna Park.

Council will use part of this funding to make the necessary improvements across the park to bring it into-line with the latest Australian Standards for safety and ensure it is fit for purpose. Improvement works are illustrated on the map and include, tree management, playground refurbishment, a new drinking fountain, a new picnic shelter and more!

After accounting for the above listed works approximately \$180,000 of remaining funds will be allocated to further enhance the use and enjoyment of the park. We know the park is muchloved by the community and we would like your ideas on how the remaining funding should be allocated.

New edging around playground Replace existing old park seat and replace with new seat New rubber softfall pads under play equipment New drinking fountain -VARNA PARK Remove existing picnic shelter and replace with new picnic shelter. Remove existing unhealthy Eucalyptus sp. VARNA STREET Remove 2 existing unhealthy Pine Trees Install no-stopping line marking along Varna Street (note this will not change current traffic conditions but will improve visibility of no-stopping area and improve road safety).

Remove existing old timber bollards and replace with new bollards

Replace existing old park seat and replace with new seat

Remove steel gate and replace with removable bollard
