
## Rickard Avenue Street Improvements



We're proposing a range of improvements to Rickard Avenue, including putting in a permanent cul-de-sac to minimise through traffic, while making it safer for local residents and cyclists merging onto Lamrock Avenue. We're also increasing public green space, building a raingarden, planting new trees and including additional seating.

## WHAT'S A RAINGARDEN?

We're installing a new raingarden with passive irrigation and improved stormwater management. The garden is designed to reduce the flow rate of stormwater and pollutant runoff, before entering the drainage network.
