

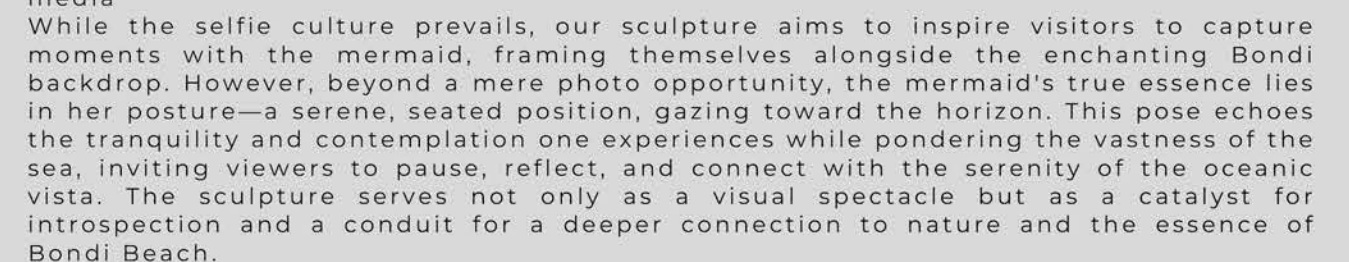

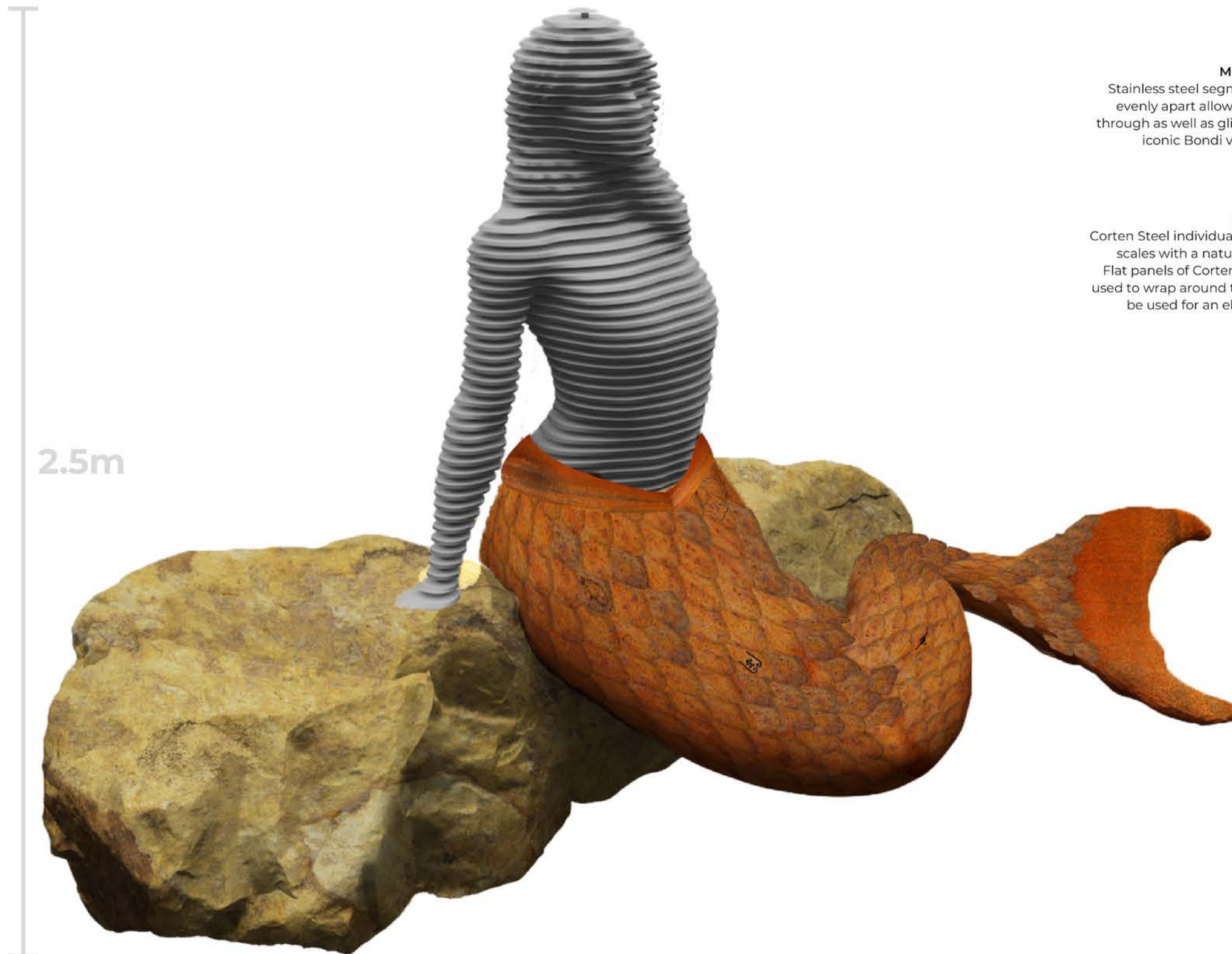

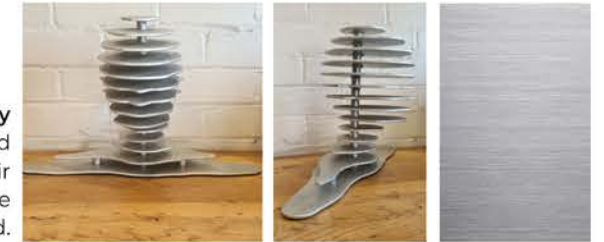

Mermaid Body

Stainless steel segments spaced evenly apart allow light, and air through as well as glimpses of the iconic Bondi views beyond.



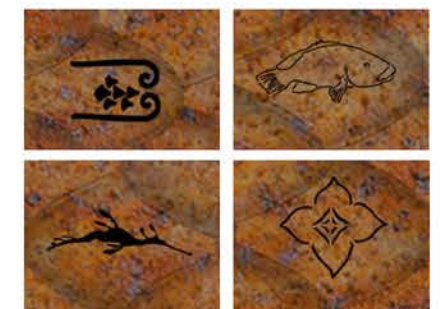
Mermaid Tail

Corten Steel individual oval shaped scales with a natural rust effect
Flat panels of Corten Steel will be used to wrap around the waist and be used for an elegant tail fin.



Rocks

The Bondi Mermaid will sit on locally sourced Sydney Sandstone rocks which will help with anchoring the sculpture as well as linking the mermaid with the Bondi coastline



Motifs

Scattered throughout will be scales that have laser cut motifs of local flora and fauna like the iconic Bondi Gropper and weedy seadragon, as well as decorative motifs referencing mermaids imagery from cultures all over the world.
